RIPLEY SCHOOLS APPROVED COLORS



HALLS SCHOOL APPROVED COLORS

PANTS, SHORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS

- Plain solid color Blue denim jeans
- Beige colored khaki or navy blue pants
- No writing or design including studs allowed on garment
- A small brand logo is permitted
- Must be worn at waist with a belt if they have belt loops
- Pants will not drag the floor and will not be cut or frayed
- No sagging, bagging, or skintight fit
- Shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be knee length

SHIRTS AND BLOUSES

- Must have a collar, either a polo shirt, turtleneck, or dress shirt with collar
- May have a small logo on chest
- A crewneck T-shirt may be worn if it has a small school name, school initials, or logo approved by the school
Logos may be embroidered or screen-printed

COATS/JACKES/SWEATERS

- Jackets and cardigan style sweaters must be one of the approved solid colors or a combination of school colors with no writing except personal name
- Trench coats are not permitted
- Lightweight jackets or cardigan style sweaters may be worn unbuttoned or unzipped
- Pullover hoodies are not permitted

COLORS

- RPS- Solid Colors-White, Purple (not lavender), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Purple/White
- RES- Solid Colors-White, Purple (not lavender), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Purple/White
- LMS- Solid Colors-White, Purple (not lavender), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Purple/White
- RHS- Solid Colors-White, Purple (not lavender), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Purple/White
- HES- Solid Colors-White, Black, Gold (not yellow), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Black/Gold
- HJH- Solid Colors-White, Black, Gold (not yellow), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Black/Gold
- HHS- Solid Colors-White, Black, Gold (not yellow), Navy Blue, Light Pink, combination of Black/Gold

FOOTWEAR

- Tennis shoes or closed toed shoes for playground or PE classes
- No rubber flip-flops, spiked heels, bedroom slippers or house shoes
- Shoes must be tied, laced, strapped or hooked
